### Introduction

Once again the British Association of Radio Control Soarers are proud to be running Interglide F5J over the weekend of 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Hamilton Farm, Bilsington, near Ashford, Kent. We are grateful to our sponsors Flightech ([www.flightech.co.uk](http://www.flightech.co.uk)) and Samba Model ([www.f3j.com](http://www.f3j.com)) for their support.

Interglide is an FAI World Cup and Eurotour event. Competitors are reminded that flying will be governed by the FIA Sporting Code. Particular attention is drawn to the regulations regarding the setting of AMTR's relating to the non-restart of motors.

**Entry is now closed for this event. All 60 places were taken up within days of the entry list being opened. If you have registered to compete but are unable to take up your place, please could you advise the CD without delay so that your place maybe allocated to people on the reserve list.**

### Location and Dates

The site is a large, private airfield located approx. 5miles south of Ashford, Kent allowing easy access from the M20, Eurostar, Ferry Terminals and local Hotels.

### Accommodation

There is free, basic camping on site with cold running water, portable toilet and chemical waste disposal.

Five electric hook ups are available for caravans on a strictly first come, first served basis at a rate of £5 per night. Please arrange when entering the campsite.

All rubbish disposal is the responsibility of those camping on the site. Please remove all debris from the camp and airstrip immediately. Remember this is a working airfield.

A buffet lunch is provided on competition days to those who have registered. There will also be a vendor providing teas, coffees, cold drinks and snacks for purchase.
