- LANGUAGES: English
- ENTRY DATES: Closing Date for entries Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June. Entries are limited to a maximum of 60 so may close earlier if full.
- In the event of the entries exceeding the maximum any further entries will be kept on a reserve list in sequence and allocated places if any competitor withdraws.
- REFUNDS: In the event of a withdrawal refunds of entry fees and any catering bookings will only be given if notification is received before 1<sup>st</sup> June

## EASA DRONE RESTRICTIONS

The British Model Flying Association has negotiated an exemption for members flying fixed wing R/C models which permits them to fly to a height in excess of 400ft.

All overseas competitors who hold FAI licenses will be covered by this exemption whilst flying in this competition.

FREQUENCIES: Frequencies allowed in the UK are 35Mhz and 2.4Ghz.

FAI LICENCE A Valid FAI License must be produced before flying
